God used this early blindness in Brian's life to begin a journey in him that has led Brian Ehrhardt to become an outstanding keyboardist, songwriter, singer, and producer. At the age of seven, a dorm parent at the School For The Blind in Aberdeen, SD taught Brian how to play "Mary Had A Little Lamb" with one finger on the piano. That would be the beginning of a lifetime of music. Within four months, he could play every song he heard. It was evident that God had blessed him with the gift of music!

God allowed Brian to endure the hardship of trial and error by playing keyboards in clubs and bars and giving into a lifestyle of drugs and alcohol. And ... at the age of 18, Brian had his first encounter with the Living God when he was invited to a church service. He responded to the altar call, and met his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, the Giver of Life!

Within a short time, Brian began writing and singing songs for his Lord. Since that day in 1982, he has been performing concerts in various churches and has traveled regionally throughout the western part of the United States.

Over time, Brian began to acquire his own recording equipment, and establish a recording studio ministry for other Christian singers by helping them with CD projects, demos and accompaniment tracks. Today, Brian is called upon to lead worship, sing concerts, and preach.

Brian and his lovely wife, Loretta, were married in 1990 and have since joined together in music ministry.
